## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1 RULES

1.1 The event will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

1.2 The class rules of the participating classes will apply and are located online as follows:

1.3 RRS 40.1 will apply (lifejackets are mandatory at all times except when changing clothes).

1.4 RRS Appendix P will apply to all classes except 420 White Sail and Optimist Green and is amended as follows: P2.3 is deleted. P2.2 is modified so that when a boat is penalized for a second or subsequent time during the event, she shall receive a 30% scoring penalty without a hearing. The penalty shall be calculated as stated in rule 44.3(c).

**1.5 RRS 63.1, A3 and A5 will be changed to permit scoring penalties for failure to comply with safety check-in/check-out procedures outlined in the Sailing Instructions.**

1.6 RRS Appendix T will apply.

Advertising will be permitted in accordance with World Sailing Regulation 20 Appendix 1.

## **3 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

3.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available after 11:00 am on July 18, 2024 at <https://theclubspot.com/register/regatta/TVhmt7NJ6F/class>

3.2 The Sailing Instructions will consist of the instructions in RRS Appendix S, Standard Sailing Instructions, and supplementary sailing instructions that will be on the official notice boards located at <https://theclubspot.com/register/regatta/TVhmt7NJ6F/class> and under the Event tent.

## **4 COMMUNICATION**

4.1 The online official notice board is located at: <https://theclubspot.com/register/regatta/TVhmt7NJ6F/class> and may be posted under the Event Tent.

4.2 From the first warning signal until the end of the last race of the day, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

## **5 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

5.1 The event is open to all boats of the Laser (ILCA 7), Laser Radial (ILCA 6), Laser 4.7 (ILCA 4), Club 420 White Sail or Spinnaker, 29er, Optimist classes and any other class with at least five (5) entries.

5.2 To compete in the C420 Canadian Championship, both skipper and crew shall be members of the **C420 Class Association**. <https://club420.org/membership/register>

5.3 To compete in the Ontario Grand Prix series, both skipper and crew shall be members of the **29er Class Association**. [www.29ercanada.org/membership](http://www.29ercanada.org/membership)

5.4 Registration for this event may **only be completed ONLINE** at <https://theclubspot.com/register/regatta/TVhmt7NJ6F/class> and will open on April 1, 2024.

*For the C420 Canadian Championship, completion of the Dinghy Regatta safety Checklist must also be completed and a paper copy presented at registration. All are required in addition to payment of the prescribed fees to be fully registered.*

6.2 A full refund, less a \$25.00 processing fee, will be granted to those entries cancelled before July 9, 2024. A 50% refund of the registration fee will be granted to those entries cancelled before 11:59 pm Thursday, July 18, 2024. No refunds will be granted after 11:59 pm Thursday, July 18, 2024.

## 7 CREW LIMITATIONS

7.1 To compete in the C420 Canadian Championship, both skipper and crew shall be members in good standing with the C420 Class Association. **Those competitors who are not members of the C420 Class Association will not be scored for the C420 Canadian Championship, only the Four Sisters Open.**

8.2 All Classes have a maximum of four (4) races per day, except Optimists may race up to seven (7).

## 9 VENUE

9.1 The racing areas will be on the waters of Lake Ontario adjacent to the Port Credit Yacht Club Harbour entrance and will be detailed in the Supplementary Sailing Instructions.

## 10 COURSES

Courses to be sailed will be detailed in Appendix S and the Supplementary Sailing Instructions.

## 11 SCORING

11.1 One race is required to be complete to constitute a series.

11.2

(a) When fewer than five (5) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When five (5) to (9) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

(c) When ten (10) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores, excluding her two worst scores.

## 12 SUPPORT BOATS AND COACH BOATS

12.1 [DP] **Support (Parent) and Coach boats shall be identified and shall be equipped with working VHF Radios.** When Code flag V is displayed, all Support and Coach Boats shall be utilized as Safety Boats and shall be under the direction of the Race Committee.

12.2 [DP] Coach and Support (Parent) Boats will be provided with an identifying flag which shall be displayed on their boat at all times while on the water. **A \$20 CASH, refundable deposit is required for the boat flag.**

12.3 [DP] No competitor or support team shall use a drone within 100 meters of the racing area.

## 13 BERTHING AND CAMPING

13.1 [DP] Coach boats and dinghies must be kept in their assigned areas which will be designated in the Supplementary Sis and/or found at <https://theclubspot.com/register/regatta/raFFwU2qru/class> .

13.2 All competitor, coach and support (parent) boats must respect member's boats including wake reduction when leaving and entering the harbour.

13.3 [NP] If you are planning on using a visitor's dock at PCYC during the event, ensure that you book your spot with the Harbourmaster at [harbourmaster@pcyc.net](mailto:harbourmaster@pcyc.net) as space is limited.

13.4 [NP] Fuel may be obtained at Lakefront Promenade Marina from **9 am-8 pm Friday to Sunday.**

13.5 [NP] Limited camping is available in designated areas only on a first come first serve basis. Anyone wishing to camp must complete the Camping Registration Application by July 18, 2024 at <https://pcyc.net/camping> and be accepted. Additional information can be found on the website.

**All groups camping must have an adult chaperone on site at all times and provide onsite contact information. The committee reserves the right to deny camping privileges.**

## **14 CODE OF CONDUCT and CONCUSSION WAIVERS**

The Code of Conduct for guests of Port Credit Yacht Club and the Province of Ontario Concussion protocol will apply. This waiver will be required to be signed by the sailor and a parent/guardian to complete registration and is located at <https://theclubspot.com/register/regatta/TVhmt7NJ6F/class>

## **15 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY/RISK STATEMENT**

The Racing Rules of Sailing 3 states, “The responsibility for a boat’s decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone.”

By participating in this event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds, rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on unstable platforms and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.

The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the event.

## **16 INSURANCE**

Each participating boat must be insured with valid, adequate third-party liability insurance or equivalent.

## **17 PRIZES**

17.1 There will be prize flags awarded to the first three finishers of each properly constituted class/division. Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.

17.2 There will be prize flags for both skipper and crew awarded to the first three finishers and Top Juniors (both skipper and crew under 16 years) in the C420 Canadian Championship.

17.3 The following awards will also be presented:

- The Marilea McAllister Corinthian Spirit Award
- Fogh Top Overall Optimist Sailor
- Ontario Sailing Grand Prix Development Series winners will be presented with flags
